Primary colours

Our primary colours are our Crohn's & Colitis UK purple which is used in our logo and 90% black which is used for our main body copy text.

Secondary colours

Our secondary colour palette has been developed for use across all communication materials, and consists of 10 colours that complement and support our primary colours and our logos.

Tints

You can use tints of all our colours to highlight or pull out important information and add variety to our materials. These should be used minimally but consistently throughout.




Secondary colours



Our primary colour purple should always be used within our materials which is then supported by a combination of secondary colours. A mixture of colour combinations can be used within one publication as long as they're used to differentiate between sections, you must not use more than one colour combination on a page. For materials such as policy documents, financial reports or summaries we suggest choosing only one type of colour combination to use across the whole publication.
