WOLUNTEER FACT-FILE MICHAEL BATE LEAD VOLUNTEER



Hi! I'm Michael, the lead volunteer for the Milton Keynes & Bedford Local Network. I was diagnosed with Crohn's disease in 2018 and after multiple failed steroid and biologic treatments, I finally went into remission in 2020 using a mixture of ustekinumab, azathioprine & octasa medication.

What does Crohn's & Colitis UK mean to me?

"They were a huge help during my diagnosis and a super important source of information to help me understand my Crohn's."

What's your IBD top-tip?

"Listen to your body!
Everyone is different and
only you know what helps
and doesn't."

What's the best thing about being a volunteer?

"Getting to meet other local people with the condition and share experiences."

Hi! I'm Abi, the Network's Finance Volunteer, and I joined the organising team in May 2022. My partner lives with Crohn's Disease and now he's in remission, I wanted to help others affected by the conditions. I also run the Network socials, so if you send us a Facebook or Instagram message, you're likely talking to me!

What is your relationship to Crohn's and Colitis?

"My partner was diagnosed with Crohn's Disease in 2018. At his worst I took on the carer role, so I have seen how debilitating the disease can be."

What's your top IBD tip?

"Lean on your partner, family, friends - when you're ill you're vulnerable and it can be really hard to advocate for yourself, so it's important to have someone who'll fight your corner when you can't."
